Proposal

I started this company when I was 20 years old after growing up and working in and around agriculture. We are a young company, established in February of 2021, with one small machine and working part time on the weekends. It did not take long before business took off and the company began to grow. We started around agriculture with fence line removal and making trails for our clients on their land. A year later we decided to expand and we purchased a small high flow excavator and hired our first employee. In the process we have stayed true to what we started with and continue to specialize in vegetation management and conservation.

In this past year, we have done many larger jobs and have begun to work with other drainage districts and municipalities. (We have only done spraying work for one district so far and that is Outagamie county, and we are currently working on getting the ball rolling with Jefferson county on similar projects), That has made us expand even more, we now have a large skid loader with one of the best forestry mulchers on the market.

This last year, we have found ourselves doing more demanding specialty work. We are now on the first stream bank restoration project to ever be done in the state of Wisconsin. We are clearing dozens of acres to be prepped for grading for wetland credits and making access to over a mile of the Cedarburg creek to be restored. This is our largest project to date, meaning when it is completed we will have been on-site for an estimated 3 months this year.

Also this year we got licensed to commercially applicate in natural areas and right of ways, along with aquatics. After being licensed, I created a sister company to L & L Clearing LLC to do the treatments; Vellema Vegetation Services LLC. We have a spraying set up that is capable of getting almost anywhere and is able to spray a direct stream up to 50', which makes it the perfect machine for spraying drainage ditches. The purpose of adding this service gives us the ability to better help our customers/clients by simplifying the process for them. We eliminate the unwanted vegetation and keep it away.

On this project I will be bringing on Kartechner Bros LLC, as well as Vellema Vegetation Services LLC as sub contractors. Kartechner Bros LLC is a local contractor near me that has been growing substantially with 50+ employees and they continue to do great work. I have known Mike and the rest of the crew for many years now and we have started to work with each other on projects. Kartechner's have been in business for 12 years now and have done work with many drainage districts over the years. Doing so, we can utilize their larger equipment, along with their forestry mulcher unit when necessary, and utilize experience. Bringing them on as a sub contractor would not only help keep cost down, but it would also help with time tremendously. Vellema Vegetation Services LLC, with myself as the applicator, would be sub contracted to treat the spraying of the regrowth. We accomplished spraying 20 miles of drainage ditch in just over 40 hours.

Since each section of right of way is so different than the other there is not just one method throughout that will be the most effective. Our intended plan is to use the forestry mulchers first then to come behind with a large excavator to pick large debris out of the ditch itself. Then we would come back with the forestry mulchers and do the finishing touches. Trees that are too large to chip will be cut down and mostly delimbed, then stacked on the outer edge of the right of way for the property owners to cut up if they choose so. Areas where that method is not efficient nor feasible other methods will be used. You can expect the same quality of finish, 'stumps cut flush' to the ground level throughout and logs stacked off to the side. If we are working along Ag fields and the farmer allows brush piles to be made we can also use that method. Once again, there is not just one method that is best.

Rock piles we come across, if any, can be buried or put on the side of the right of way or hauled away if necessary.

With that being said, expected production per mile will vary vastly. We will be striving for quality and efficiency throughout and you should expect to see 1-3 miles of ditch with a right of way on both sides each year. We will be transparent with communicating on estimated production of each area we enter with the chairman as the work takes place.
